The Regular Meeting of the Ojai Basin Groundwater Management Agency was called to order at 5:00 PM at the Pope Plaza Conference Room.

- 1. **PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD:** Mac Lejowsky spoke on the well permit for Ojai Valley School at 723 El Paseo Road.

 - c. Kear Groundwater monthly Report: Kear provided a power point presentation on the Ventura River Watershed Basin Surface and Groundwater Interaction.
